THE SHORT FILM

The film takes place in a rural village in the heart of Africa and tells the story of a teenager who dreams of raising himself and his younger sister out of poverty. But when a twist of fate shatters his hopes, everything seems lost and he is faced with the ultimate choice.

Mercy's Blessing is a story of selfless love and sacrifice in the midst of social injustice. It highlights the power of the human spirit, the power of choice and the ability of young people to act with courage, despite great odds in upholding equality and justice.
